This letter serves as notification to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE), Solid Waste Division, that the Kansas City Board of Public Utilities (KCBPU) is closing the Nearman Creek Power Station Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Surface Impoundment, Permit No. 0413. It is anticipated that the CCR Surface Impoundment will not be operational between April to May 2018 timeframe. KCBPU will be submitting relevant construction quality assurance plans and drawings in the near future for KDHE approval. KCBPU will coordinate all closure activities and schedules with KDHE.
