The original design/bid package drawings and specifications for the Bottom Ash Impoundment at the Nearman Creek Power Station show that the bottom and sides of the impoundment were constructed with an impervious material. Although the material is indicated as impervious, the hydraulic conductivity is not specified as required per the CCR Rule §257.71(a).

Black & Veatch has determined the documentation for the impervious material to be accurate.
